After a short time in Somerset he moved back to Yorkshire before rejoining Equine Reproductive Services (UK) Ltd in 2013 becoming a Director in 2016.

He completed the RCVS Equine Stud Medicine Certificate in 2008 and has been an honorary lecturer at Liverpool University since 2014 and also lectures regularly at veterinary conferences.

He is involved in all aspects of equine stud medicine including natural, artificial insemination and embryo transfer breeding methods on all types of horses and ponies. Aside from the reproductive work he is regularly involved in racing, sport horse and pleasure horse veterinary care.
